## **Admission requirements for visiting undergraduate students at the University of Concepción (UdeC)**

- Motivation letter stating the area of interest you are applying for (i.e., the Faculty and the study programme)
- Academic transcript of the grades obtained in the courses and modules hitherto taken
- Letter by the tutor or the Director of International Affairs of your home university
- Brief CV
- Photocopy of the passport
- Health insurance
- Knowledge of Spanish at level B1 (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) certified by the Instituto Cervantes, the language centre of your home university, or a test conducted by the Spanish Department at UdeC
- You may start applying for the corresponding visa once you receive the admission letter from UdeC's Office of International Affairs.
- No housing options are available at UdeC for international students. However, the University offers assistance by means of OFIS to accommodate the visiting students.

Thank you for your interest in studying at the University of Concepción. We are pleased to inform you that our University offers a wide array of study programmes to international students.

The first term of the academic year comprises the period from March to July, whereas the second term lasts from August to December. The deadline to apply for any programme during the first term is October 31 of the previous calendar year, while applications for the second term may not be submitted after May 31 of the current calendar year.

The tuition fee is USD \$2,000.— per semester, and includes IT services as well as the access to libraries, sports, student fares for public transport etc. You will be studying at our University as a visiting student.

Please refer to the application form to be advised about the admission requirements. Furthermore, it is imperative for the applicant to show proof of a health insurance which, at least, covers medical costs, medicines, medical examinations, and repatriation costs.
