Institutional Nomination	
Procedure	The International Office of the institution of origin must complete the UdeC nomination form, detailing information on students candidates who will pursue exchange studies at UdeC.  After being determined eligible, the students will be responsible for completing their applications.  The required documents are attached.  (See student's application)
Deadline for nomination	First Semester: from September 1st to October 15th Second Semester: from April 1st to May 15th
Nomination deadline for all the programs of the Medical School	First Semester:  • First call: from August 15th to September 15th  • Second call: from October 1st to October 15th  Second Semester:  • First call: from December 1st to January 5th  • Second call: from April 1st to May 15th

Procedure	Once the request for nomination has been approved, the nominated students and institutional authorities for exchange studies will receive an email from the account: <a href="mailto:exchange@udec.cl">exchange@udec.cl</a> with the instructions for accessing the UdeC Application Platform, a virtual site where the students can enter information regarding:  1. Personal background 2. Academic exchange project 3. Required documentation

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR INSTITUTIONAL NOMINATION TO UDEC

The nomination of student candidates for exchange studies at UdeC must be done through the following online form: <u>Acceso Formulario de Nominación UdeC.</u> This form is designed to be completed by the responsible authority for exchange studies at each partner institution.

The form permits the nomination of a maximum of 4 students. If there are additional requirements, you must contact <a href="mailto:exchange@udec.cl">exchange@udec.cl</a> explaining your request.



The form has the following 3 sections:

- 1.Information on the institution of origin
- 2.Identification of the institutional authority responsible for exchange studies
- 3. Student Nomination Information.

Once the information has been entered, click the send button. After eligibility has been determined, the "UdeC Office of International Affairs" will contact institutional authority responsible for exchange studies as well as the students in the days following the nomination, indicating the instructions for directly accessing the exchange student platform. The nominated students will be responsible for completing the application stage.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENT APPLICATION TO UDEC


Once the request for nomination has been approved, the nominated students as well as the institutional authority reponsible for exchange studies will receive an email from <a href="mailto:exchange@udec.cl">exchange@udec.cl</a>, with the instructions for accessing the Student Application Platform, a virtual site where the students can enter information regarding the academic exchange project, attaching the required documentation.

#### 1. Personal background information



In this section, the nominated student can confirm or correct his or her personal and academic information provided by his/her Institution of origin.

### 2. Academic Exchange Project



In this section, the nominated student must select his/her courses during the period of exchange at UdeC. The system permits the selection of a maximum of 6 courses form up to 3 different UdeC programs. In addition, a checkbox is available where elective or complementary courses can be entered.

Of all the courses chosen, at least 50% must be selected from the UdeC program of interest.



Additionally, the course called "Academic Spanish Literacy (Alfabetización Académica en Español)" will be available. This course is exclusively for international students from non-Spanish speaking countries.

Please consider that to apply for an exchange at a graduate level, the applicant must be in possession of a bachelor's degree or be already enrolled in a master's degree program.

#### 3. Required documents



In this section, the nominated student must attach the required documentation:

- Academic transcripts or grade reports showing courses taken at the Institution of origin at the time of application in English or Spanish
- Cover letter: a letter briefly summarizing academic exchange interests.
- Curriculum Vitae (CV) or resume
- **Certificate of Spanish level:** Certificate of Spanish B1 or higher. (Certificate from Instituto Cervantes, Certificate Servicio Internacional de Evaluación de la Lengua Española (SIELE) or accreditation of level attained by the institution of origin)
- Passport: Copy or photograph of passport. (optional at the time of application, but document is mandatory in order to obtain a letter of acceptance from UdeC)

Once the necessary information has been entered, the student can submit his or her exchange application.

The UdeC Office of International Affairs will contact the responsible institutional authority as well as the students to inform them of the decision regarding their applications. Upon having been accepted, the corresponding letter of acceptance to Universidad de Concepción will be sent.
